The scope of this statement is limited to the Conflict Minerals currently defined as Tin, Tantalum, Tungsten, and Gold; also referred to as 3TG minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and neighboring countries.

E-MAX Instruments, Inc. has contacted our direct suppliers of products that include Gold, Tin, Tungsten and Tantalum and certifies to the best of our knowledge that our supply chain does not contain any minerals or materials originating from, or processed within, the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries.
